

**TOWNSHIP OF MECOSTA
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
LOCAL WATERCRAFT CONTROL ON
THE MUSKEGON RIVER AMENDMENTS**

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Mecosta Township Board of Trustees of the Township of Mecosta, Mecosta County, Michigan will hold a public hearing on October 10, 2023 at 5:30 p.m. at the Township Hall, 19729 11 Mile Road, Big Rapids, Michigan, to hear and consider comments on proposed amendments of Watercraft Controls Upon the Waters of the Muskegon River, WC 54-92-001 Slow No Wake, Ordinance 3 of 1992, South and North of the Davis Bridge, M-20. And amendments to WC 54-96-001, Ordinance 1 of 1996, North of the Rogers Dam.

Mecosta Township would like to amend WC-54-92-001, Ordinance #3 of 1992. The current Slow-No Wake starts on the North Side of the Davis Bridge, M-20 (8 Mile Rd) and extends South, downstream 1750'. The township would like to extend 650 feet to the North side of Davis Bridge-M-20 and 2,300 feet to the South side of Davis Bridge-M-20, which is downstream.

Mecosta Township would also like to amend WC-54-96-001, Ordinance #11 of 1996, Muskegon River; for high speed from 6:30 p.m. – 10:00 a.m.. The township would like to repeal WC-54-96-001 and have Slow-No Wake 24 hours a day to start at the township boundary on 12 Mile Rd/183rd Ave and extending Southerly to 11 Mile Rd, Sections 1 & 2, T14N, R10W, Township of Meocsta, County of Mecosta, State of Michigan.
