## Fee Clarifications

Item #2, Mobile Home Unit Site:

WHEN an item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee plus the number of unit sites. WHEN setting a mobile or modular home on private property, a permit should include the application fee, a sewer or building drain, and a water service or water distribution pipe.

## Instructions for Completing Application

General: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid if work is progressing, and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not completed within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time commencing of the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.
